In India 70 per cent of the labour force reside in rural areas and depend on low productive agricultural activity where there is huge underemployment leading to low level of productivity. The high proportion living in poverty among women in India is due to their concentration in low productivity work.

The skill strategy needs to focus on strategy of skill development should be aimed at addressing the skill needs of the self-employed as well as the casual employed. To quote Economic Survey 2013-14, "India can increase its long-term trend growth by unleashing the entrepreneurial spirit of millions across the country by strengthening the economic freedom of the people."

Thus, skill development of the self-employed is essential to make the transition from own account workers to employers or entrepreneurs.
